



Idioms related to Friendship



Two peas in a pod

means

Inseparable, Very close to each other in their friendship

example

They are always together; they are like two peas in a pod.

A shoulder to lean on

means

Help and support from someone

example

Gloria always gives me a shoulder to lean on

Know someone inside out

means

To know someone very well

example

I know exactly what he likes; I know him inside out.

Through thick and thin

means

In good and bad times

example

Vera is always with me through thick and thin

Bend over backwards for someone

means

To do everything possible to help someone

example

When Sami was in big trouble, Jim bent over backwards for him
