Yonder (adj.)

being at a certain distance,
usually within view

Over
there

“Run to yonder hut and get the cutters
for me,” said Pa.



uttermost (adj.)

farthest away; outermost

Example:

I wonder how old the stars are at the uttermost parts of our galaxy.



horizon(noun)

where the land or water seems to meet the sky

Example:

Watching the sun sink beneath the horizon is an amazing sight.



immensity (noun)

hugeness , vastness

Example:

I was shocked at the immensity of the trees in the redwood forest.

interior (adj.)

inside or indoors [\neq exterior]:

Example:

*The interior walls
are all painted
blue.*





Thicketed (v)

covered with a thick growth of shrubs or small trees

The island was thicketed with berry-producing bushes.
